Day 1

Arrival to Berlin Proceed airport formalities Meet the driver and transfer to the hotel Overnight in Berlin

Day 2

Breakfast at the hotel

Pick up from the hotel by rikshaw and depart fo a 3 hours private tour of Berlin Our journey through time on three wheels. Experience the past and present of Berlin in the field of tension between the Middle Ages, Prussia's glory, Eastern modernism and the new capital. From the shadow of the television tower, it goes first over the Nikolaiviertel to the Museum Island. Along the street Unter den Linden we then head for the Brandenburg Gate, including a pan across the Gendarmenmarkt.

We move you on both sides of the Spreebogen and bring you closer to the changeful history of this area. During our leisurely round, you will of course see the Bellevue Palace and the Reichstag as well as the numerous new buildings such as the Chancellery, Houses of Representatives and Parliamentary Library. Via Tiergarten it goes to Potsdamer Platz. Get your own picture of Berlin's new crowd puller.

Then we will show you the remains and the course of the Berlin Wall between the former Checkpoint Charlie and the memorial on Bernauer Strasse.

Day 3

Breakfast at the hotel

Reach the meeting point on your own and depart with a small group for a 6 hour tour to Potsdam

Explore Potsdam's main attractions, baroque streets, and elegant castles on a guided walking tour from Berlin. Take the train to the city of kings and Kaisers and learn about the city's long history and faithful restoration. Marvel at the Rococo style at Sanssouci Palace, the former residence of Frederick the Great, and uncover the hidden secrets of its architecture. Learn how Frederick expanded the city magnificently during his time as a patron of the arts and where he is buried in Sanssouci. Pass the Church of Peace in the palace grounds of Sanssouci Park, which is referred to as "the German Versailles". Continue through elegant streets, manicured gardens, and charming water fountains and discover the Dutch Quarter and

the impressive Nauener Gate. Go to Cecilienhof Palace to learn why Potsdam is so important to the history of World War II. Hear how Stalin, Churchill, and Truman divided Germany during the Potsdam Conference in 1945. Arrive lakeside to admire the Marble Palace with its Greek temple ruins and continue along the banks of the Havel River. Here, cross the Glienicke Bridge, better known as the "Bridge of Spies", to see where the CIA and KGB exchanged secret agents.
